What is an implant?

An implant is a screw inserted in the upper or lower jaw by the dentist to **replace the natural root of a lacking tooth**.

Once the **implant** is inserted, the bone adheres to it and

natural tooth


abutment

grows around it.

The **abutment** is tightened to the implant to support the **crown**.
